

### **Prize Desk**

There are First Overall trophies for **ALL** Intermediate/Novice events. We will give Section Top Awards for any **Pairs** event. Prizes will be awarded from results posted in the *Daily Bulletin*. The only exception will be awards for the Sunday events; they must be picked up within one hour of the end of the event. **No prizes will be mailed**. The prize table is located in the main hallway. 
